Teams are encouraged to make a poster A3 size with this information as well and we will post them in the venue.

**FIRA Sports, Air, Challenge (Pro) have two choices:**

Choice 1.) Team description paper (5 pages)

Describe your team

Describe your research program

Describe your robot. Hardware, software.

Describe software packages that you use

Describe the components if your system in detail: Vision, motion planning, navigation, walking, ...

Teams should create a A3 poster that will be shown during ICAHRR.

Choice 2.) Research paper (10 - 15 pages)

Traditional research paper describing contribution to knowledge in state of the art robotics. Includes description of novel algorithm or hardware design and a critical evaluation.

Selected research papers will be presented at the ICAHRR brake out session. Based on feedback from ICAHRR, authors should revise their papers and we will submit a longer version of the paper to a journal special issue.
